OPINION

of the ROMANIAN SENATE, on the

Proposal for a REGULATION (EU) OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Regulation (EC) No 1406/2002 establishing an European Maritime Safety Agency

The Senate of Romania has checked the compliance with the subsidiarity and proportionality principles of Proposal for a REGULATION (EU) OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Regulation (EC) No 1406/2002 establishing an European Maritime Safety Agency according to the provisions of the Treaty of Lisbon (Protocol no.2).

Taking into account the report of our permanent Committee for economy, industry and services, **the Plenum of the Senate**, during its session of the 8-th of December 2010, has found that the mentioned proposal, elaborated according to Article 100 par.2 of the TFEU, **is compliant with the subsidiarity and proportionality principles** and provides the necessary means to enhance overall maritime safety and ship pollution prevention rules.
