of the ROMANIAN SENATE, on the

Proposal for a Regulation (EU) of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down specific measures in favour of agriculture in the smaller Aegean islands

The Senate of Romania has checked the compliance with the subsidiarity and proportionality principles of the **Proposal for a Regulation (EU) of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down specific measures in favour of agriculture in the smaller Aegean islands – COM (2010)767 final**, according to the provisions of the Treaty of Lisbon (protocol no.2).

Taking into account the report of our permanent Committee for agriculture, forestry and rural development, **the Plenum of the Senate**, during its session of the 9th of February 2011, has found that the examined proposal is **compliant with the subsidiarity and proportionality principles**.
