OPINION

of the ROMANIAN SENATE, on the Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on the Common Fisheries Policy

COM(2011) 425 final

The Senate of Romania has checked the compliance with the subsidiarity and proportionality principles of the Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on the Common Fisheries Policy – COM (2011)425 final, according to the provisions of the Treaty of Lisbon (Protocol no.2).

Taking into account the report of our permanent Committee for agriculture, forestry and rural development, **the Plenum of the Senate**, during its session of the 24th October 2011, has found that the examined proposal, elaborated according to Article 43 paragraph (2) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union (TFEU), is in compliance with the principle of subsidiarity and the principle of proportionality, but after assessing the substance of the proposal, it was adopted the amendment that "In Annex III - Advisory Councils to be introduced the Advisory Council for the Black Sea".
