Dear President,

The Commission would like to thank the Camera Deputaților for its Opinion concerning the proposal for a Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on measures facilitating the exercise of rights conferred on workers in the context of freedom of movement for workers {COM(2013) 236 final}.

The Commission notes with satisfaction the Camera Deputaților's strong support of this initiative.

The Commission can confirm that Article 5 of the proposal for a Directive allows Member States to choose to enable existing bodies, structures or agencies to advise and support EU migrant workers to exercise their rights to free movement.

In addition, the proposal sets out a common framework of appropriate provisions and mechanisms for enforcing at national level the rights conferred by Article 45 TFEU and Regulation (EU) No 492/2011. Member States remain free to maintain or introduce more favourable provisions as they see appropriate.

The Commission looks forward to continuing our political dialogue in the future.
