SUMMARY

of the Opinion "Energy Union Package - The Paris Protocol – A blueprint for tackling global climate change beyond 2020" – COM(2015)81

Referring to the Opinion on "Energy Union Package - The Paris Protocol - A blueprint for tackling global climate change beyond 2020"- COM(2015)81 final,

The Chamber of Deputies:

- supports the proposal of the European Commission concerning the conclusion of an international Protocol on the action plan for fighting against the climate changes after 2020, with the characteristics specified in the Communication, namely: a large geographic coverage, a full coverage of the sectors and emissions, which represents an ambitious target based on solid commitments meant to reduce the harmful effects;
- supports the proposal of the European Commission according to which the Protocol should establish a procedure, applicable to all Parties, so that to raise the ambition targets of the existing commitments, to revise them periodically and to establish ambitious goals for the future;
- stresses upon the relevance of the lands use sector as to the resilience in the field of food security and other environment, social and economic benefits for individual encouragement as well as common actions aiming at preparing and adapting to the harmful effects of climate changes, in parallel with implementing courageous measures aiming at diminishing them;
- agrees that economies based on low carbon emissions, resistant to climate changes can be achieved only through major changes of the investment models, underlying the additional difficulties generated by the negotiations linked to the Transatlantic Trade and Investment Partnership, in designing the actions aiming at combating the climate changes.
