

**Opinion of the Romanian Chamber of Deputies on the
Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament, the Council,
the European Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of the Regions
on enabling the digital transformation of health and care in the Digital Single
Market, empowering citizens and building a healthier society
COM(2018) 233**

The Chamber of Deputies supports, in principle, the initiatives of the Commission on digital transformation of health services, but expresses its concern on a series of aspects such as: exposure of health data to digital ransom (*ransomware*); inequality regarding access to quality care services due to discrepancies of digital competences existing between citizens; replacing the human presence by robotic medical services; the risk of overwork of health professionals in the selection and evaluation process of relevant health data. At the same time, the Chamber recommends setting up alternative, classic, safety systems, in order to ensure resiliency of the healthcare system in exceptional situations, such as disasters.
