Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament, the Council, the European Council, the European Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of the Regions – Building a stronger Europe: the role of youth, education and culture policies

The Chamber of Deputies supports the strategic approach of the role of youth, education and culture policies and considers that sustained efforts are needed in order for the Single Market to adapt to the new realities of globalisation and in the cultural field. It also aims at enhancing these policies as well as vocational training in order to build a stronger Europe, based on the knowledge economy, the entrepreneurship and sustainable development.
