

**Opinion of the Romanian Chamber of Deputies on the
Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council establishing
“Erasmus”: the Union programme for education, training, youth and sport and repealing
Regulation (EU) No 1288/2013
COM(2018) 367**

The Chamber of Deputies supports the Erasmus programme, the “DiscoverEU” initiative and the establishment of the European Education Area by 2025.

The Chamber of Deputies recommends extending the approach on developing entrepreneurship in all areas of economy, together with the digital area, in Union strategies on youth and in the implementation of the Erasmus programme.

The Chamber of Deputies considers that is necessary to promote the complementarity of the Erasmus programme with other Union programmes and policies, and that is necessary to intensify transnational and international communication between organisations in the field of education, training, youth and sport.

Nonetheless, the Chamber of Deputies recommends reducing the administrative burden for beneficiaries and implementation bodies, simplifying formalities and prohibiting excessive bureaucratic practices.
