Opinion of the Romanian Chamber of Deputies on Amended proposal for a Council Decision on the conclusion, on behalf of the Union, of the Common Aviation Area Agreement between the European Union and its Member States, of the one part, and Georgia, of the other part COM(2018) 495

The Chamber of Deputies supports the conclusion of the Common Aviation Area Agreement between the European Union and its Member States, of the one part, and Georgia, of the other part, in the conditions described in its current proposal for a Council Decision. The Chamber of Deputies recalls that Romania was the first state from the EU to ratify the Association Agreement EU-Georgia. The Chamber of Deputies notes that the Eastern Partnership and the enlargement policy of the EU are priorities for the Presidency of the Council of the European Union which Romania will hold in the first semester of 2019. Last but not least, the Chamber of Deputies supports Romania's involvement in the enlargement efforts of the European Union, in order to ensure a stable framework of cooperation and harmonisation, in accordance with the needs of the Member States.
