- 1. Underlines that promoting modern technologies and responsible professional conduct in business, commercial relations, obtaining mutual benefices after a solid investment policy and following an advanced diversification of economies on both continents, involve a partnership between as many Member States, on one hand, and African states on the other hand, which might be obtained more faster through a strong effort of the European Commission to make known the business opportunities of the Africa-Europe Alliance.
- 2. Proposes the support of business mission at Union level in African states which are under the general average of development for the continent in order to identify cooperation possibilities in the economic area and in education and culture.
- 3. Supports the stimulation of the boosting for attracting investments in Africa via blending and guarantees, in order to reduce the risk and to give priority to sectors with added value, to small and medium enterprises, and disruptive and innovative enterprises.
