Opinion of the Romanian Chamber of Deputies on the Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament, the Council, the European Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of the Regions – A sustainable Bioeconomy for Europe: Strengthening the connection between economy, society and the environment COM(2018) 673

The Chamber of Deputies:

- 1. Welcomes and supports the interest for a sustainable bioeconomy for Europe, which contributes to the strengthening of the industrial base of the European Union, by creating more ecologic and efficient new value chains and industrial processes in terms of costs.
