

**Opinion of the Romanian Chamber of Deputies
Proposal for a Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council
On the mobilisation of the Flexibility Instrument to finance immediate budgetary
measures to address the on-going challenges of migration, refugee inflows and security
threats
COM(2018) 708**

The Chamber of Deputies:

1. Considers that the current Multiannual Financial Framework proved to be inadequate for addressing a series of crises, new international commitments and new political challenges which were not integrated or anticipated at the time of adoption.
2. Considers that, in view of the Multiannual Financial Framework post-2020, it is necessary to increase the budgetary responsibility by reorienting the budget towards results and performance, and in view of flexibility, it is necessary that the future Multiannual Financial Framework be more flexible, but in the same time predictable, with simplified mechanisms.
3. Underlines that the EU budget should be adaptable in order to respond to new challenges and to guarantee the responsibility of the Union and its capacity to respond to emergent needs, additional challenges and new international commitments.
