

**Opinion of the Chamber of Deputies on the  
Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament, the European  
Council, the Council, the European Central Bank, the European Economic and Social  
Committee, the Committee of the Regions and the European Investment Bank  
COM(2019) 195**

The Chamber of Deputies supports the position of the European Commission which considers that the orderly withdrawal of the United Kingdom from the EU as the only outcome able to ensure the rights of the citizens regarding fundamental freedoms and social security, preservation of the internal market integrity, respect for social, environment and sustainable development values, the efficient and regulated functioning of international trade operations.

The Chamber of Deputies appreciates the availability of the Commission to discuss all aspects related to the possibility of a withdrawal without agreement and to continue multilateral preparations in this aspect.

The Chamber of Deputies recommends that additional support be provided, in particular, for small and medium-sized enterprises and additional funds for funding sources, as well as for the use, in the event of a no-deal Brexit, of all European funds and specific instruments.
