## Opinion of the Romanian Chamber of Deputies on Proposal for a Decision of the European Parliament and of the Council on the Strategic Innovation Agenda of the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT) 2021-2027: Boosting the Innovation Talent and Capacity of Europe COM(2019) 330

The Chamber of Deputies supports the Proposal for a Decision on the Strategic Innovation Agenda of the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT), having in regard the necessity for a more ambitious approach and opened to new in regard to recognising and supporting initiatives that reflect scientific excellence.

In the same time, however, it recommends that the implementation of the Strategic Innovation Agenda should be accompanied by administrative rules including mechanisms for verification of assessors' competences, in the field of state-of-the-art technologies and in terms of interdisciplinary implications. Regarding the correlation to the development of education systems, stresses the need to boost the education component, a wider opening to pre-university education and non-formal learning, in areas other than information technology.

The Chamber of Deputies considers it necessary for the diversification of partnerships to include the whole spectrum of interested entities, particularly from the civil society, SMEs, as well as from the agricultural sector, and proposes the establishment of a citizens' information mechanism on how the funds are used and on the assessment of the impact of the operations financed.
