

**Opinion of the Romanian Chamber of Deputies on the  
Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament and the Council  
Report on the implementation of national Roma integration strategies – 2019  
COM(2019) 406**

The Chamber of Deputies supports continuing the efforts to improve the policy areas of the EU framework on national Roma integration strategies targeting education, employment, health and housing, as well as collecting data at European level on best practices of fighting discrimination and antigypsyism, and expresses its political support to establish and implement programmes on European level in order to combat the attitude of mistrust of Roma in themselves.

Also, it recommends approaching education, fighting discrimination and antigypsyism as a component part of the inclusive European social model, which will ensure a common future and will allow the materialisation of desires and aspirations of all the citizens of the Union.

At national level, the Chamber of Deputies considers that the national Roma integration strategy must continue to look for formulas of implementation with real results and reiterates that involving all decision makers is necessary, including civil society organisations, other than those of the Roma community, in the activity of promoting the fight against discrimination.
