

**Decision of the Chamber of Deputies
On the Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament, the European
Council and the Council**

Progress report on the Implementation of the European Agenda on Migration
COM(2019) 481

The Chamber of Deputies

- supports the strengthening of European migration and border security policy; stresses the need for a sustainable migration management system, including with regard to the distribution of refugees between Member States, in order to respond to future difficulties in time and to prevent loss of life and criminal activities of migration;
- supports the continued support of the Member States facing the greatest pressure, in particular through hotspot areas;
- supports the integration of refugees into the labor market and emphasizes the attention to be paid to minors, especially to young people;
- wishes to be informed about developments in hotspot areas and about the situation of minors;
- with regard to Libya, supports efforts to alleviate the current humanitarian crisis and the transition to democracy, a functioning state and prosperity;
- with regard to Syria, supports efforts for a rules-based international order as well as for the conviction of crimes committed in that country; recommends monitoring the effectiveness of the EU Regional Trust Fund in response to the Syrian crisis;
- supports the continuation of EU support to Turkey in order to prevent increased illegal migration flows; appreciates the progress made in meeting the benchmarks for visa liberalization in relation to Turkey and urges the parties to step up efforts in that direction.
