

**Opinion of the Romanian Chamber of Deputies on the
Joint Communication to the European Parliament and the Council
European Union, Latin America and the Caribbean: joining forces for a common
future**

The Chamber of Deputies recommends taking certain common actions for developing the human capital, supporting access of small and early-stage enterprises to the market of Latin America and the Caribbean, as well as broadening the cooperation in the area of sustainable urban development. The Chamber of Deputies underlines the necessity for cooperation in the field of managing relevant natural genetic resources and traditional agricultural knowledge, in order to contribute to achieving the sustainable development goals and the integrated management of ecosystems. Moreover, it supports enhancing the common efforts to maintain the multilateral trade system open, non-discriminatory and based on rules, having in its centre a strong and functioning World Trade Organisation, acting towards its reform and its functions of regulation, monitoring and conflict resolution.
