## Dear President,

The Commission would like to thank the Camera Deputaților for its Opinion on the Communication to the European Parliament and the Council on the shaping of the Conference on the Future of Europe {COM(2020) 27 final}.

European solidarity remains at the heart of the Commission's unprecedented measures to fight this virus.
