

**Opinion of the Romanian Chamber of Deputies on the  
Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament, the Council, the European  
Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of the Regions  
A European strategy for data  
COM(2020) 66**

The Chamber of Deputies, expressing its position in principle for the need to implement a European Data Strategy, recommends, in this context:

- Ensuring between the flow of data and its widespread use and ensuring high standards of confidentiality, safety, security and ethics;
- A consultation for the sustained and balanced participation of SMEs in databases that only the large technology enterprises have access to at present;
- Ensuring a regulatory framework to govern the possibility of rapid intervention to ensure a real competitive system;
- Extending the Copernicus programme infrastructure, supporting European data spaces;
- Supporting non-formal learning actions through specific tools and means.
