

**Opinion of the Romanian Chamber of Deputies on the  
Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament, the Council,  
the European Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of the Regions  
on achieving the European Education Area by 2025  
COM(2020) 625**

The Chamber of Deputies welcomes the proposal of the European Commission on the European Education Area, especially since this area was an important topic of the COSAC Plenary meeting in Bucharest, in June 2019.

In this context, the Chamber of Deputies considers that national policies in the area of education and European Union's support policies should take into account issues such as strengthening non-formal education, the necessity to increase investments in the education infrastructure, the need to quickly acquire skills required by the labour market. Also, a highlight was put on supporting the exchange of best practices between Member States on long-term educational policies, on stimulating research in education sciences, but also on supporting remote regions of the Union to achieve specific objectives of the European Education Area.
