

**Opinion of the Romanian Chamber of Deputies on the
Joint Communication to the European Parliament and the Council
The EU's Cybersecurity Strategy for the Digital Decade
JOIN(2020) 18**

The Chamber of Deputies recommended supporting the civil society at European Union level in order to help promote awareness on the danger of cyber threats, especially in Member States with limited experience in combating them. It also recommended supporting scientific research to develop advanced technical defences against cyber threats, such as continuous encryption or the use of artificial intelligence to detect network anomalies.

At the same time, the Chamber of Deputies drew attention to the increased vulnerability of institutions, enterprises and households, as a result of the expansion of online education during the pandemic and proposes to collect Member States' initiatives to counter these threats.
