The Chamber of Deputies supports the approach and actions proposed for the new European Bauhaus, but draws attention over the fact that this initiative must be implemented through the existing institutional and regulatory framework so as not to increase the administrative and fiscal burden.

It also stresses that the involvement of small and medium-sized enterprises is essential and recommends that rural projects, in particular those in remote or hard-to-reach areas, be supported as a matter of priority.

The Chamber of Deputies supports initiatives on adequate professional training for the new European Bauhaus and recommends supporting research in education sciences through Horizon Europe to meet the human resource requirements for the new European Bauhaus.

The Chamber of Deputies considers it necessary to include in the New European Bauhaus development strategy distinct objectives of preserving soil biodiversity, increasing the surface of urban green areas and increasing resilience to disasters.
