

**Decision of the Romanian Chamber of Deputies to adopt the
Opinion on the Proposal for a Council Recommendation
on individual learning accounts**

COM(2021) 773

The Chamber of Deputies supports the European Commission's proposal on personal learning accounts, but points out that non-formal, informal and self-taught learning is of interest to adults and is suitable for a wide range of educational activities. It is therefore recommended that the new support framework to facilitate the use of learning opportunities should also include courses that are not in learning accounts in order to support a learning environment as flexible as possible and with as many opportunities as possible.

The Chamber of Deputies stresses the importance of an information campaign concerning these personal learning accounts in order to reach all potential beneficiaries who will also need appropriate guidance and recommends continuing efforts to increase the European Union's human capital in education sciences and to persevere in supporting innovation in teaching and methodical activities.
