

**Decision of the Romanian Chamber of Deputies to adopt the  
Opinion on the Proposal for a Council Recommendation on learning for environmental  
sustainability**

**COM(2022) 11**

The Chamber of Deputies supports learning for environmental sustainability and considers necessary to include topics in various fields in order to ensure the acquisition of practical skills directly used in biodiversity management.

To this end, recommends the involvement of local communities in carrying out and supporting the work on learning for environmental sustainability, as well as the use of European Union support instruments.

The Chamber of Deputies considers education on environmental sustainability to be essential for a successful green transition, for an energy policy favourable to European consumers, especially vulnerable ones.

It is also recommended to develop a harmonized classification at European Union level and analyze the outcomes of activities on learning for environmental sustainability in order to identify the best practices.
