A European Health Data Space: harnessing the power of health data for people, patients and innovation

The Chamber of Deputies recommended developing IT solutions allowing access to health databases and information regarding health insurance systems in the Member States. It also recommended to increase the support given to borderline scientific and technical research and laboratory medical experiments and the use of data to underpin public policies on ageing. In addition, it proposed to initiate research studies to identify technical methods for cooperation between human health data interpretation and artificial intelligence contributions. Considered it essential to harmonise the health systems of the Member States for the cross-border use of health data, in particular the results of medical imaging investigations.

Last but not least, the Chamber of Deputies stressed that is welcome to ensure a common governance of health data, strengthened at national and EU level.
