A Digital Decade for children and youth: the new European strategy for a better internet for kids (BIK+)

COM(2022) 212

The Chamber of Deputies:

- Supports the new European strategy "A better internet for kids";
- Recommends the cooperation of the EU with content creators for internet, enhancing efforts of the EU to increase specialised knowledge in the field of artificial intelligence and to integrate it in education systems, supervising social media platforms, internet of things and future evolutions in the field of digitalisation (big data);
- Supports the adaptation of education systems to digitalisation and the cooperation, in the field of the new strategy, between the authorities with responsibilities regarding internet safety and organisations with concerns in formal and non-formal education;
- Supports the creation of information portals on the security of children on the internet and development of recommendations on the use of the internet for educative purposes;
- Recommends specific protection measures for children facing intra-EU mobility;
- Recommends that actions for a safer internet for children be coordinated with those aimed at protecting private and family life in the EU; stresses the need for a strict control of the collection of personal data about children and their processing.
