

**Decision of the Romanian Chamber of Deputies
to adopt the Opinion on the
Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament, the Council, the European
Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of the Regions
EU Solar Energy Strategy
COM(2022) 221**

The Chamber of Deputies:

1. Recommends supporting European solar energy production and identifying solutions to reduce the dependence on raw materials and components from third countries.
2. Recommends the development of a harmonised regulatory framework at EU level for the installation of new production capacities for new prosumers and micro-grids based on solar energy.
3. Recommends the development of standards to facilitate the integration of solar energy equipment industry in the European Union, including voluntary standards that could be adopted by the Solar PV Industry Alliance.
4. Underlines that the effort of the Member States to adopt incentives for the development of agri-PV systems when drawing up their National Strategic Plans for the Common Agricultural Policy would be more effective if accompanied by a harmonised framework at European Union level.
5. Stresses that solar energy units should occupy as limited areas as possible and integrate as far as possible into the natural environment and in the landscape of the site.
6. Recommends that guidelines be drawn up for the creation of skills in using management programmes of geographic information systems, since school.
7. Recommends stepping up support for the space sector as an opportunity to obtain energy and necessary data for optimal use of solar energy.
