Council, the Council, the European Economic and Social Committee and the Committee  
of the Regions  
REPowerEU Plan  
COM(2022) 230**

The Chamber of Deputies:

- Supports the REPowerEU Plan, energy efficiency measures (in particular in public administration and public spaces) and those relating to alternatives to energy production (especially at local level);
- Stresses the transatlantic integration of energy markets between EU and US, as well as the importance of EU's contribution to defending Ukraine against energy threats from the Russian Federation;
- Supports the acceleration of the energy transition (with reference to the supply of critical raw materials, the development of emerging energy technologies); affirms the importance of producing energy equipment in the EU;
- Affirms the importance of a pan-European approach of harnessing natural gas resources in EU Member States and expanding transport and storage infrastructure for liquefied natural gas;
- Supports the encouragement of non-formal education in the field of skills needed to produce renewable energy.
