

**Decision of the Romanian Chamber of Deputies to adopt the
Opinion on the
Communication from the Commission to the European Parliament, the Council, the
European Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of the Regions
A New European Innovation Agenda
COM(2022) 332**

The Chamber of Deputies:

- Affirms the importance of education (including older people), non-formal learning and public information for innovation;
- Supports the access to the single market, funding, including through Horizon Europe and Erasmus+ programmes and through the programmes of the European Innovation Council, for highly innovative enterprises, especially of small and medium-sized enterprises from rural areas, and reducing bureaucracy;
- Supports the international competitiveness of innovative enterprises from the EU and the stimulation of venture capital funds to invest in these kind of enterprises;
- Recommends the prudent use of the innovation gender and diversity index to avoid market distortion.
