Decision of the Romanian Chamber of Deputies to adopt the Opinion on the

Proposal for a Council Recommendation on strengthening prevention through early detection: A new EU approach on cancer screening replacing Council Recommendation 2003/878/EC

The Chamber of Deputies, expressing its position in support of the proposal presented by the European Commission on the new EU approach to cancer screening underlines the need for coordination between Member States to ensure timely access to health data and advanced imaging for authorities and citizens, as well as continued efforts to reduce inequalities between Member States in the fight against cancer. At the same time, the Chamber of Deputies recommends that measures be identified at European Union level to speed up the transposition of scientific knowledge and innovative technologies on cancer screening into common practice, to develop combined policies at Union level on cancer prevention, with the involvement of the parliaments of the Member States in order to take into account national and regional responsibilities.
