on 15 June 2016

Regarding negotiations on the Transatlantic Trade and Investment Partnership (TTIP) between the European Union and the United States, and regarding the Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement between the European Union and Canada (CETA)

The European Affairs Committee of the National Council of the Slovak Republic

- A. Takes note**
of the information on the current state of negotiations on the Transatlantic Trade and Investment Partnership (TTIP) between the European Union and the United States;
- B. Reiterates**
that the Committee considers the TTIP and CETA as mixed agreements;
- C. Firmly requests**
the involvement of national parliaments of the EU Member States in the decision-making of these agreements, and that the Commission and the Council of the European Union desist from the CETA's provisional application, pending a final decision regarding the competence of the European Union in terms of deep and comprehensive trade and investment agreements;
- D. Requests**
the Minister of Economy to regularly inform the Committee about the progress in the TTIP negotiations (about significant amendments to the consolidated text);
- E. Authorises**
The Chairman of the Committee
to inform the Speaker of the National Council of the Slovak Republic, Minister of Economy of the Slovak Republic, European Parliament, Council of the European Union, and the European Commission about the discussion's results.
