The Commission would like to thank the Cortes Generales for their Opinions on its proposals on establishing contingency measures concerning aviation safety {COM(2018) 894 final}, road connectivity {COM(2018) 895 final}, the European Maritime and Fisheries Fund {COM(2019) 48 final}, social security coordination {COM(2019) 53 final}, the implementation and financing of the general budget of the Union in 2019 {COM(2019) 64 final} and the continuation of ongoing activities under the Erasmus+ programme {COM(2019) 65 final} with regard to the withdrawal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland from the European Union.

The Commission appreciates that the Cortes Generales has analysed these proposals so expeditiously. It also welcomes the confirmation that action at European level is necessary and the support to the proposals' general aim to mitigate the negative effects of a possible disorderly withdrawal of the United Kingdom.
