



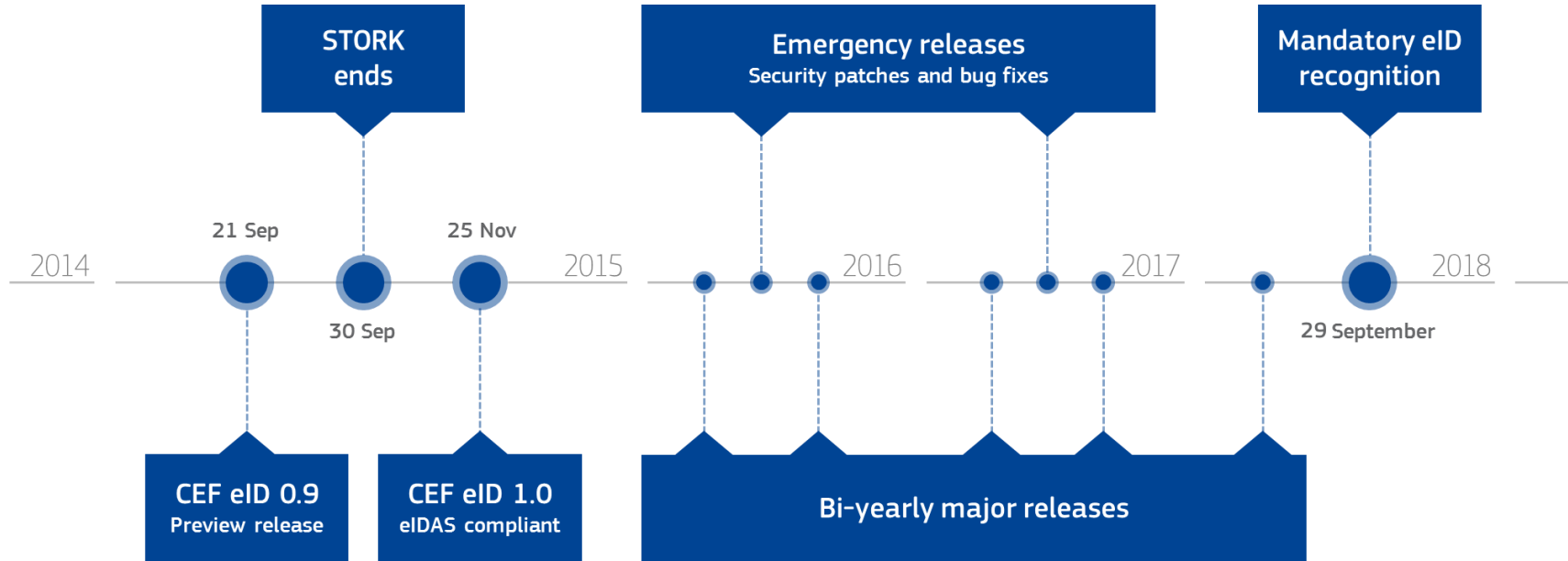

Countries in process of implementing an eIDAS compliant Node

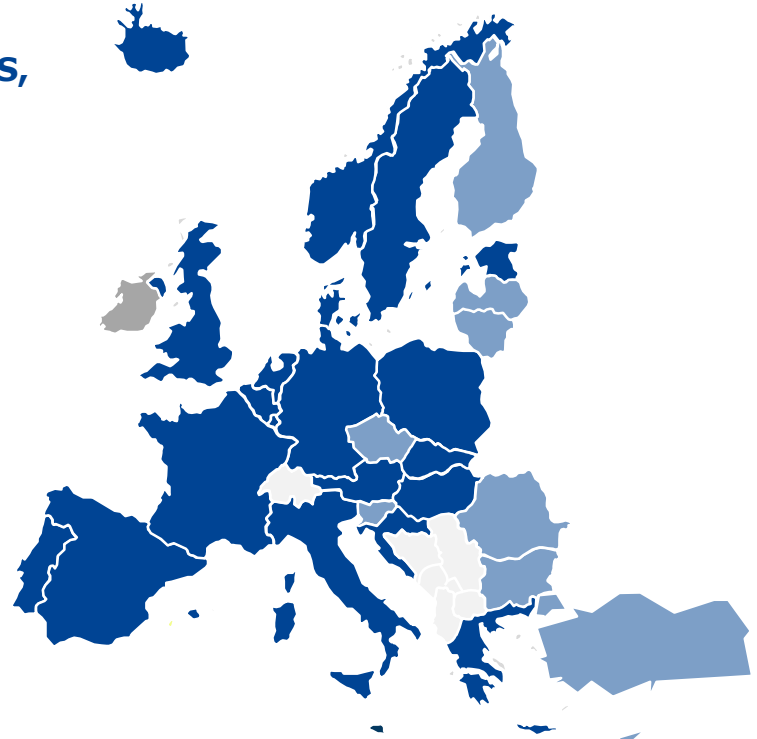

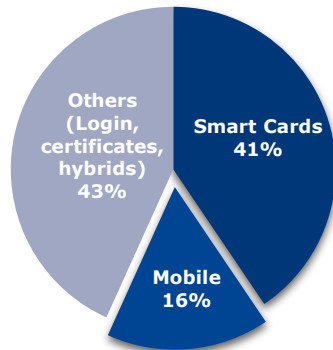

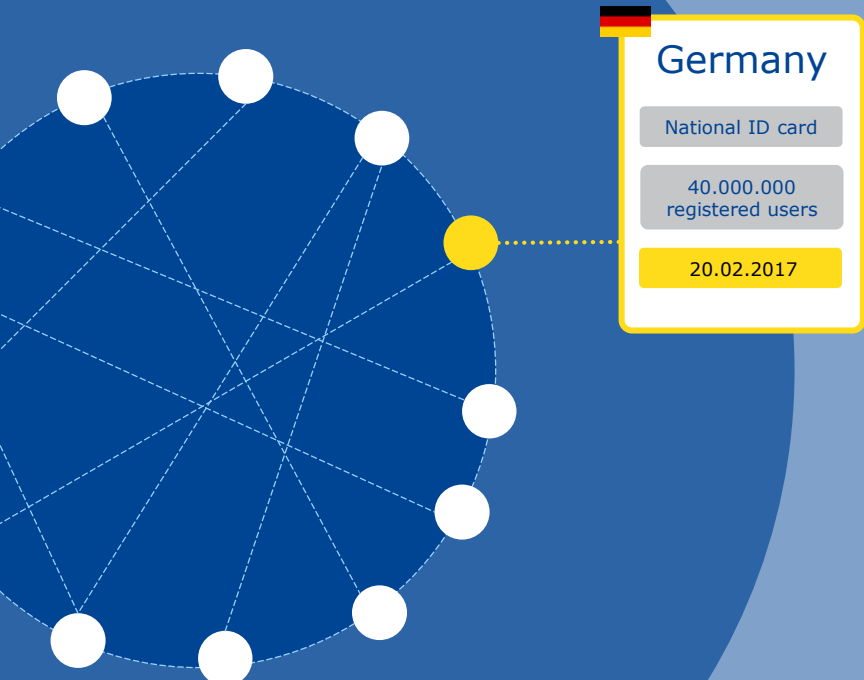

- 20 February 2017: first pre-notification
- A milestone towards establishing eID and trust services in Europe achieved!

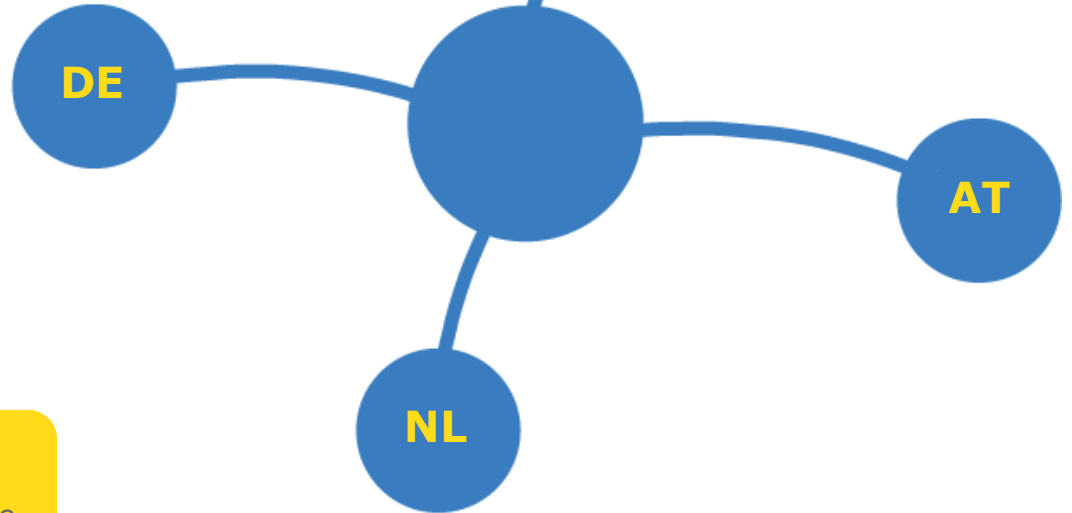
... and **5 more countries** are intending to pre-notify their schemes **by the end of 2017** !



Other encouraging achievements

- In December 16, The Netherlands, Austria and Germany have managed to **connect their identification and authentication systems** via their (technically compliant) eIDAS nodes in production

- In December 2016, Spain **completed CEF eID conformance testing**, a service provided by the European Commission's Directorate General for Informatics (DIGIT).

Ongoing dialogue with the private sector in the United-Kingdom

GOV.UK Verify has a private sector engagement team who are carrying out several discoveries with the private sector. They are engaging with private

sector through the Open Identity Exchange UK (<http://oixuk.org>) on various projects, including the financial, medical and airline sectors, the sharing economy and others.

Call for reuse of the Estonian SSO

eIDAS-Connector Node will be a part of **national SSO solution** and all private sector service providers are encouraged to use it, although not free of charge.

Testing services in Sweden

Both public and private sector can test their connection to the Swedish eIDAS node for eID and Trust services. www.eidasweb.se
