It provides a single point of access to the tools related to eIDAS trust services in a way that each tool is targeted to a specific community of users, has its own operational functions, and accesses shared information collected as part of operational functions of the other tools.

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1. Introduction to CEF eSignature EU Trust Services Dashboard service

CEF eSignature helps public administrations and businesses to accelerate the creation and verification of electronic signatures (e-signatures). The deployment of solutions based on this building block in the EU Member State facilitates the mutual recognition and cross-border interoperability of e-signatures, so that their legal value can be recognised in countries other than the country of origin of the signer.

1.1. Objective

The EU Trust Services Dashboard unifies and centralizes the CEF eSignature building block tools and information related to the eIDAS trust services backbone, for the purpose of augmenting existing features and gradually implementing new initiatives into a continuous improvement approach.

1.2. Users

The CEF eSignature EU Trust Services Dashboard service is intended for the following type of users:

- Representatives of the EU Member States mandated to notify elDAS information (also known as "notifiers"). This information includes National Accreditation Bodies (NABs) and the Conformity Assessment Bodies (CABs) they accredit, Qualified electronic Signature/Seal Creation Devices (QSCDs), bodies designated to certify these devices, and Article 30.3(b) and 39.2 alternative processes.
- Anyone interested in the information present in the EU Member States' trusted lists (TL), in the European Commission's list of the trusted lists (LOTL), and the aforementioned notified information.
- **Notification verifiers and publishers** that verify and publish the aforementioned notified information.
- **TL quality supervisors** that monitor the global TLs quality (or "health status").

1.3. Benefits

The CEF eSignature EU Trust Services Dashboard delivers the following benefits to its users:

- Provide tailored access with single point of entry;
- Boost user experience and eSignature adoption, thanks to:
 - Unified look-and-feel (eUI) and an intuitive interface, presenting human-readable information on trust service providers, TL, LOTL, CABs, NABs, QSCDs, etc.
 - FAQ and homepage guiding the user through the tools and boosting the awareness of the eIDAS.
- Ensure consistent information among tools.
- Centralize user administration and system configuration.
- Provide sound and evolutive framework for future tools.

1.4. Scope

The table below presents an overview of the phases and the corresponding services offered by CEF eSignature EU Trust Services Dashboard.

2. How to use the service step-by-step

This chapter presents information on how to use the CEF eSignature EU Trust Services Dashboard, including the roles and responsibilities of different actors involved in it.

The URLs that can be used to access the relevant services are provided in the previous section.

2.1. Any user (general public)

Role: Browse the available information.

Responsibilities:

- Discover the CEF eSignature EU Trust Service Dashboard and eIDAS by browsing all tools available on its pages.
- Browse the trusted lists. In particular, the user can browse the information present in the EU
 Member States' trusted lists and in the European Commission's list of the trusted lists (LOTL)
 and check the existence of a trust service provider and the qualified status of the trust services
 it provides.
- Browse the compiled lists of information related to eIDAS. In particular, the user can browse:
 - National Accreditation Bodies that accredit eIDAS Conformity Assessment Bodies;
 - eIDAS Conformity Assessment Bodies;
 - Qualified electronic Signature Creation Devices and Qualified electronic Seal Creation Devices;
 - Secure electronic Signature Creation Devices benefiting from the transitional measure set in Article 51(1) of the eIDAS Regulation;
 - Notified designated certification bodies under Article 30(2) of the eIDAS Regulation;
 - Designated bodies under Article 3(4) of Directive 1999/93/EC;
 - Article 30.3(b) and 39.2 alternative processes of the eIDAS Regulation.

2.2. eSignature service providers

Role: Validate an implementation of electronic signature validation platform.

Responsibilities:

Download and browse the eSignature validation test cases.

2.3. Notifiers

Role: Users eligible to notify lists

Responsibilities:

• Notify eIDAS information (NAB, CAB, QSCD, certification alternative processes), expect information related to the national trusted list scheme. A TLSO is therefore not considered as a notifier.

2.4. Verifiers

Role: Users eligible to verify the content of notified lists.

Responsibilities:

• Verify before publication the content of notifications (e.g. notifications of NAB, CAB, QSCD) excluding notifications relating to the national trusted list scheme.

2.5. Publishers

Role: Users eligible for notified lists publication.

Responsibilities:

• Publish the verified content of the notification to make it publicly accessible.

2.6. TL quality supervisors

Role: Users eligible to monitor the global TLs quality (or "health status").

Responsibilities:

- Measure the trusted lists quality (by checking their content with good practices and noncompliance with technical specifications);
- Browse the evolution of the trusted lists and the evolution of their quality (or "health status").

2.7. CEF eSignature

Role: Maintain CEF eSignature EU Trust Services Dashboard.

Responsibilities:

- Host the tools;
- Maintain the tools;
- Provide support and explanations on how to use the CEF eSignature EU Trust Services
 Dashboard. Support requests may be made via the CEF eSignature Service Desk or by
 contacting the CEF eSignature onboarding manager.
