


What is CEF eInvoicing?

- CEF eInvoicing was introduced to support the **Directive 2014/55/EU on electronic invoicing in public procurement** and the **European standard for eInvoicing**
- On 16th April 2014, the European Parliament and Council adopted the Directive to set up one **single pan-European standard for eInvoicing**
- The Directive was a direct consequence of the many standards for eInvoicing across Europe and as successor of the PEPPOL project's initial work on eInvoicing
- The standard and its definition is maintained by **CEN**, but the European Commission will assist through its CEF work programmes *more on this later...*




CEF eInvoicing – Milestones & services






CEF eInvoicing – Overview of Service Offering



Supporting service: Trainings – Implementation workshops

Implementation workshops allow for dialogue between the EC and different target audiences

The cost-free workshops should enhance the knowledge of CEF eInvoicing in the Member States



- **On-site** material for Implementation workshops
- Typically at least one full or one half-day workshop
- Possibly in combination with **bilateral meetings** between the EC and the Member States' representatives



Supporting service: Trainings – Online trainings



Remote sessions (Sub-elements from overall on-site material)

- 1-3 hour-long sessions provided through EC training platforms such as Webex
- Focused training sessions on key areas derived from the on-site workshops



Webinars (key focus areas)

• 1 hour-long sessions with core elements from on-site and remote trainings to gain expertise in key areas



Web material (key highlights)

• Overall presentation material provided on CEF Digital and CEF eInvoicing collaborative spaces







Which organisations are responsible for the implementation of eInvoicing in each country?

How can the Commission support each country in the implementation of the eInvoicing Directive?





Has your government prepared specific plans or strategies for implementation of the Directive 2014/55/EU and of the eInvoicing Standard?





High-level timeline


