Digital Europe Work Programme

- Work Programme 2023-2024
 - Adopted in April 2023
 - European Digital Identity and Trust Ecosystem: **20M**
 - eDelivery budget: **5M** for the two years
- Amendment of the WP 2024
 - No changes for eDelivery

2030 Digital Decade Policy Programme

In force since 8
Jan 2023.

- Designed to promote innovation and investment in the (EU) through:
- setting a clear direction and measurable **targets for digital transformation** in the EU by 2030;
- structuring the **cooperation** between the European Parliament, the Council of the European Union, the European Commission and EU Member States ;
- encouraging consistent, comparable, transparent and complete EU **monitoring and reporting**.

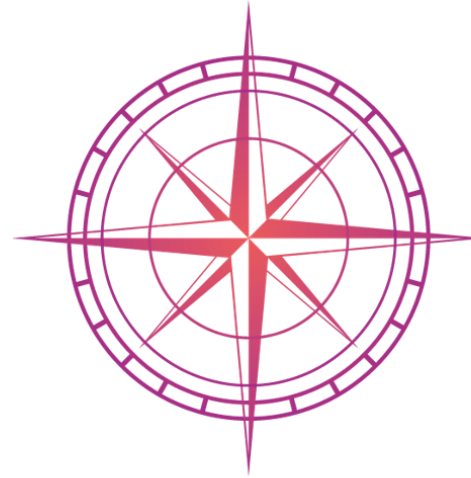
Digital Targets

Skills

20 million employed **ICT specialists**, more graduates + gender balance
80% of adults can **use tech** for everyday tasks

Government

Key Public Services - 100% online
Everyone can **access health records online**
Everyone can use **eID**



Infrastructure

Gigabit connectivity for everyone, **high-speed mobile coverage** (at least 5G) everywhere
EU produces 20% of world's **semiconductors**
10 000 **cloud edge nodes** = fast data access
EU **quantum computing** by 2025

Business

75% of companies using **Cloud, AI or Big Data**
Double the number of **unicorn startups**
90% of **SMEs taking up tech**



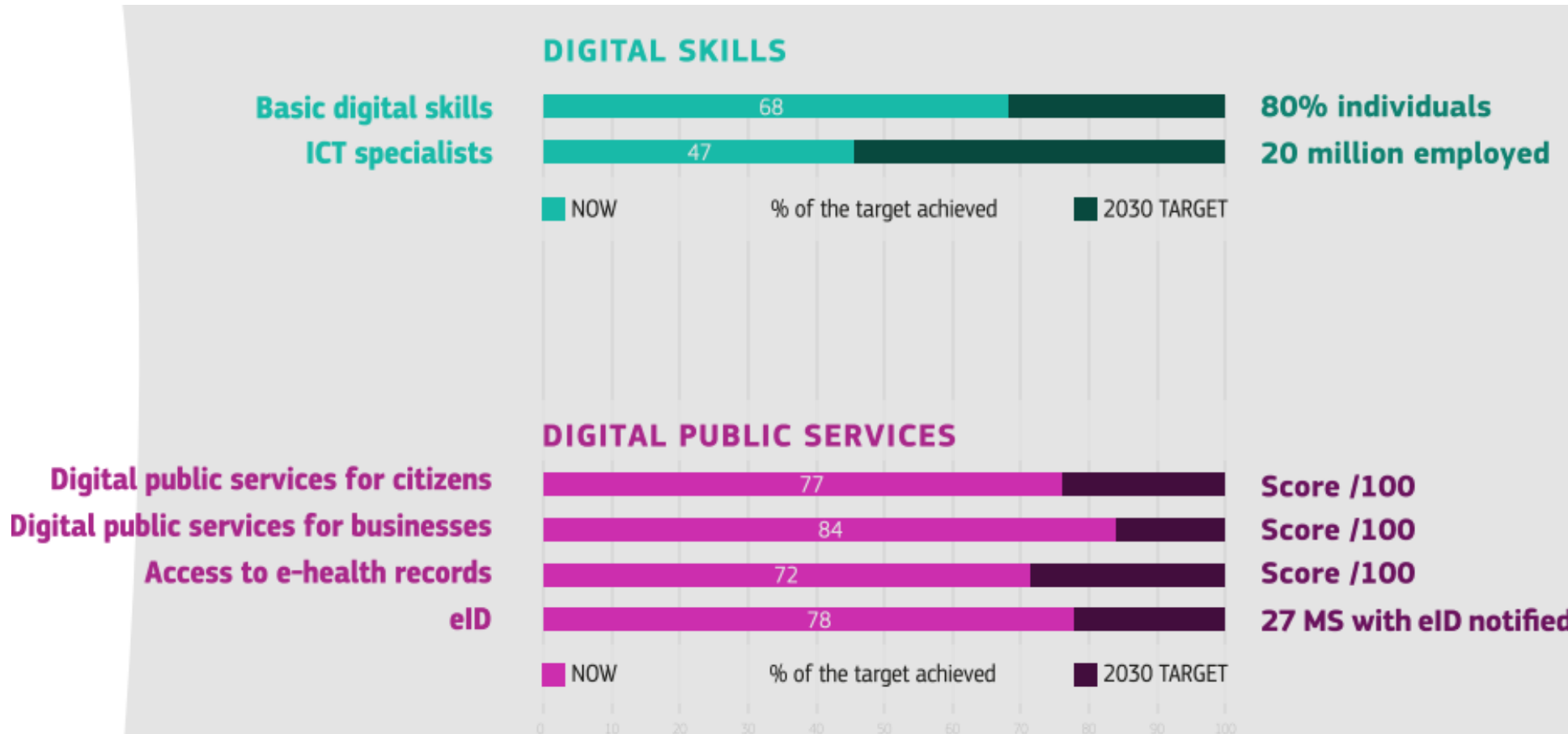
Target for eID:

- 100 % of Union citizens have access to a secure electronic identification (eID) means recognised throughout the Union, enabling users' full control over identity transactions and shared personal data
- Linked to eIDAS Regulation and its revisions

2023 – 1st Report on State of Digital Decade

- Published on 27 September 2023
- Takes stock of the EU's progress towards a successful digital transformation as set out in the Digital Decade Policy Programme 2030.
- Highlights need to accelerate and deepen collective efforts, including through policy measures and investment in digital technologies, skills and infrastructures.
- Includes recommendations to Member States ahead of adopting their national roadmaps.

Progress towards digital targets



Recommended policies, measures and actions for Member States

- Adopt a whole-of-government approach to digitalisation; consolidate, streamline and coordinate policy action at all levels of governance; steer investments to accelerate progress towards targets
- Increase investment in digital R&I across sectors; invest in critical infrastructure and technologies of interest for EU's digital sovereignty; seek to achieve the public and private expenditure target of 3% of GDP
- Use national roadmaps as strategic tool towards the above goals
