

Data Spaces Support Centre



- The DSSC published version 0.5 of the Data Spaces Blueprint
- The use of eDelivery would fall under the 'Data Exchange Building Block'
- By design, eDelivery only provides a subset of the required features, but could be used in conjunction with other standards
- The DSSC building block also includes (out of scope of eDelivery):
 - Payload definition
 - Defined methods to methods to query, update and delete data



Pilot/PoC projects

eDelivery support for OOTS Projectathon

- At the October Projectathon 23 Member States have tested the Once-Only Technical System
- The information exchange works as expected
- Ongoing study to explore advantages of different network configurations, including dynamic discovery
- Use of non-Domibus solutions:
 - Finland used Harmony
 - Belgium used Domibus, but will move to Tradeshift for eDelivery as a service



Union Database for Biofuels (UDB)



- Art. 28(2) Directive (EU) 2018/2001:
 - "The Commission shall ensure that a **Union database** is put in place to enable the tracing of liquid and gaseous transport fuels [...]"
 - "Member States shall require the relevant economic operators to enter into that database information on the transactions made and the sustainability characteristics of those fuels, including their life-cycle greenhouse gas emissions, starting from their point of production to the fuel supplier that places the fuel on the market."
 - "A Member State may set up a national database that is linked to the Union database ensuring that information entered is instantly transferred between the databases." → planned use of eDelivery

Union Database for Biofuels (UDB)




- The Union Database for Biofuels (UDB) is a register for all certified biofuels, bioliquids, and biogas that count towards EU targets for renewable energy.
- The UDB aims to ensure the tracing of liquid and gaseous transport fuels <...> in the transport sector in any Member State.
- The registration under the UDB should be compulsory for all Economic Operators (EOs) from 1 January 2024.





New draft profiles finalised.

Public consultation opened at the end of June (eDelivery AS4 2.0 | SMP 2.0).



Approach to cryptography



- Discussed at:
 - Interoperability Forum on 27 June 2023
 - ENTSOG Workshop on Data Exchange and Cybersecurity
- EdDSA vs ECDSA:
 - it is still uncertain Certification Authorities will offer EdDSA certificates
- Key transport vs key agreement:
 - the complexity of key exchange was questioned
 - security expert was again consulted
 - a more detailed analysis will be published
- Addressing of incorrect referencing of HKDF in RFC9231 underway

Product Updates

Domibus, DomiSMP & DomiSML







Domibus 5.0.x & 5.1.x patches

- Significant performance bugs resolved (for high-performance systems)
- Significant non-performance bugs resolved
- Many SQL upgrade issues were addressed

Support arrangements extended

- Versions 5.0 & 5.1 will be supported for a longer period since Domibus 5.2 will move to Java 8 to Java 11 and Java 8 may no longer be usable
- The longer support period will ensure users (esp. of WebLogic) who cannot upgrade to Java 11 yet still have LTS and non-LTS supported versions they can continue using







Apache Santuario, Apache WSS4J, Apache CXF:

- Libraries that provide a Java implementation of the security standards for web services
- Used by Domibus and other Java-based eDelivery Access Point implementations

Significant contributions to Apache libraries:

- Contributions for Apache Santuario & Apache WSS4J already submitted to the libraries' maintainers to support the algorithms introduced by the new profile
- Will enable both Domibus (as of version 6.0) and all other Java-based eDelivery Access Point implementations to be able to implement support for the algorithms introduced by the new profile



- Predefined security profiles now support new cryptography algorithms
- Plugin enable/disable option via global property

- Transition to Springboot application
- Upgraded crypto algorithms
- CPPA scope expansion
- New message priority handling at the party level
- Extended support for Split & Join

Product updates: DomiSMP 5.0





- Multi-document type support (SMP 1.0, SMP 2.0, CPPA 3.0/CPP)
- Support for ECDSA & EDDSA XML signatures
- Support for SpringBoot (simplified testing)
- New UI look and feel
- Multiple security tokens
- Flexible role management for privacy control
- Versioning support
- Expanded platform support (WebLogic 14c, Tomcat 9, MySQL 8)






- Support missing features for OOTS / eFTI Exchange Environment
- Allow referencing of one document (e.g. the metadata of a service provider) by multiple participants (e.g. who are using that service provider)
- Migration to new Documentation framework

Product updates: DomiSML 4.3






- Support for OCSP certificate validation
- Support for XML signature algorithms, particularly ECDSA & EdDSA
- Support for multiple new signature key types
- Flexible keystore and truststore choices
- Enabled case sensitivity, with the option to make schema mandatory
- Added a tool deactivate/reactivate and remove unused SMPs
- Added a tool to update logical/physical addresses of SMPs
