

Upcoming specification changes regarding Dynamic Discovery

Context


Upon MS request, the **Once-Only Technical System** (using eDelivery) commissioned a study on the use of dynamic discovery.

A decision regarding the use of dynamic discovery is pending.

An OOTS decision to use dynamic discovery will call upon the **eDelivery Building Block** to address **several gaps** identified in the study.

EU goes Once Only

The Once-Only Technical System is the first EU-wide cross-sectorial and cross-domain dataspace for secure government-to-government data exchange. Send a request as an EU citizen or business and it will simplify your online administrative procedures.







eDelivery specification changes required for OOTS scenario

- Gap 1: Allow hybrid approach between 4-corner model (for messaging) and point-to-point model (for dynamic discovery)
- Gap 2: Ensure confidentiality of the SMP metadata (URL)
- **Gap 3**: Support for C3 node requesting sender (C2) certificate




Challenge

Why are cross-border procedures so difficult?

There are different evidences required across the Member States for administrative procedures, most of them not standardised at EU level


There are many evidence providers in each Member State and no easy way to know who they are

It is not easy for administrations to confirm that evidence citizens upload is authentic and up-to-date




The Once-Only Technical System lets EU public authorities securely exchange official documents and data at the request of citizens and businesses as part of cross-border administrative procedures, e.g., when registering an address or vehicle when moving abroad. This innovative system eliminates the complicated manual search, mapping, and fetching of data between Member State authorities, improving efficiency, making people's lives easier, and reducing the costs of mobility in the Single Market.



The Once-Only Technical System is live since 12 December 2023 reusing eDelivery




Architecture of the Once-Only Technical System (OOTS)



OOTS from the perspective of the Citizen ¬ Business

- ✓ The website is provided by a Member State competent authority responsible for one of the procedures in scope of the SDGR.
- ✓ The procedure requires users to provide evidence
- ✓ That evidence can be retrieved via the OOTS from another Member State.





eDelivery usage in OOTS

- OOTS uses the eDelivery common profile with the 4corner enhancement
 - Access Points are (for now) statically configured
- All <u>conformant solutions</u> are supported
- Configuration is possible with the help of
 - OOTS specifications
 - OOTS Support Team





State of play in Member State implementations

- Member States are still in the process of onboarding
- Solutions are being looked for
- A dynamic growth in Access Points is expected
 - Future-oriented thinking: reusing Access
 Points for other initiatives as well
- Information on different solutions and their value propositions could help Member States select the best fit for their organization





Two remote sessions (11 & 25 June) to test connectivity between proof-of-concept implementations of eDelivery AS4 2.0 specifications

We will simulate a mesh network to test interoperability between different AS4 implementations.

Initial test plan

Exchange messages:

- one-way push AS4
- one payload
- signed and encrypted
- recipient to validate signature and decrypt

Participants will test sending and receiving messages within their group or the entire network, depending on the number of participants.





We will publish Interoperability Event guidance documentation by the end of April

The participant resources will include the following:

- Support artefacts and lessons learned from the development of the POC carried out by the eDelivery team
- Description of configuration parameters and digital certificates that participants should share with eDelivery before the event
- Description of where participants can find the metadata needed to configure their Access Point when enabling connections with other participants
- Details on test cases that will be proposed for the participants to run, as well as the steps participants are encouraged to execute for each test case
- Details on how participants will provide feedback on the results of the test cases and how support for investigation and troubleshooting could be carried out after the event





To participate, please let us know by mid-May, then share your certificates by the end of May.

Step 1. Prepare your implementation

Implement the latest eDelivery AS4 2.0 specifications. Solutions in proof-of-concept or work-in-progress stages are welcome.

Step 2. Pre-register (by 15 May)

Step 3. Share your URLs & certificates (by 30 May)

Establish URLs, generate and submit a signing certificate and an encryption certificate.
