



The DSSC published version 1.0 of the Data Spaces Blueprint, where eDelivery falls under the 'Data Exchange Building Block'

Recommended Standards

Although specific APIs can sometimes be necessary, an initial adoption of a **general-purpose API** is recommended. This API has to be **independent from the data structure** to be shared. *It also needs to provide features for executing complex queries. Notably, support for temporal queries (during specific time periods) or geoqueries (in particular areas) should be available, supplementing basic operations such as creating, modifying, updating and removing contents.* As long as the participants in the data space are unknown, the standard should be **well-documented** and **available in the market** to facilitate their participation in the data space.



Pilot/PoC projects

Central Electronic System of Payment informatic (CESOP)

- **Purpose**: CESOP is designed to enhance EU Member States' abilities to combat VAT fraud through improved transparency in cross-border payments.
- **Functionality**: Payment service providers in the EU must report the recipients of more than 25 cross-border payments per quarter starting from April 2024. This data is centralised in CESOP for analysis.
- **Use**: CESOP makes the data accessible to anti-fraud experts across Member States, aiding in the detection of possible VAT fraud, particularly in e-commerce.
- **eDelivery** used for data transfer from MS authorities to DG TAXUD (first large transfer successful in April).

Carbon Border Adjustment Mechanism (CBAM)

- An EU initiative designed to address carbon leakage by ensuring that the price of imports reflects their carbon content.
- **Purpose**: CBAM charges a fee on imports of carbon-intensive goods to match the EU's carbon pricing, preventing companies from relocating production to avoid higher standards.
- Begins with a transitional phase from 2023 to 2026, leading up to full implementation by 2026.
- **Goods covered**: Initially applies to cement, iron and steel, aluminium, fertilisers, electricity and hydrogen.
- **Transitional phase**: Importers report greenhouse gas emissions without needing to buy certificates; full reporting requirements will gradually take effect.
- From 2026, importers must register and buy CBAM certificates corresponding to the carbon emissions of their imports.
- eDelivery (TAPAS) assessed for secure system-to-system communication with CBAM central platform.

Dynamic Discovery in OOTS

Context

- Once-Only Technical System study on the use of dynamic discovery identified several gaps.
- An OOTS decision to use dynamic discovery will call upon the eDelivery Building Block to address these gaps.

EU goes Once Only

The Once-Only Technical System is the first EU-wide cross-sectorial and cross-domain dataspace for secure government-to-government data exchange. Send a request as an EU citizen or business and it will simplify your online administrative procedures.

Dynamic Discovery gaps



- **Gap 1**: Allow hybrid approach between 4-corner model (for messaging) and point-to-point model (for dynamic discovery)
- **Gap 2**: Ensure confidentiality of the SMP metadata (URL)
- **Gap 3**: Support for C3 node requesting sender (C2) certificate



Cooperation with ETSI



Following public consultation, ongoing eDelivery-ETSI discussions to:

- Align on AS4 mapping in the newly proposed framework for ERDS (as part of the eIDAS2 review/restructuring)
- Assess if ETSI can play a role in filling some of the standardisation gaps in standards used by eDelivery

Product updates: Domibus development



- Focus of last 6 months: maintenance/support due to growing product complexity and growing user base
 - Docker images
 - QA issues
 - Platform evolution/issues
 - Major library replacement for security assurance
 - Increasing performance demands
- Latest releases: Domibus 5.0.8 and 5.1.4 resolving a large number of issues





Product updates: Domibus development

- Further activities:
 - Moved technical documentation to new site
 - Implemented changes to security patching approach
 - Separated SQL scripts for upgrades
 - Contribution to Java libraries related to new 2.0 specifications
- Current activities:
 - Preparing Domibus POC for testing 2.0 specs during Interoperability Event
 - Work on Domibus 5.2 (long-support version) to be released in Q4 2024





Product updates: Secure deployment guidelines for Domibus

- Security patches will only be issued for Domibus installations that comply with the <u>Domibus Secure Deployment Recommendations</u>.
- Emergency security patches will be prioritised for compliant installations. Non-compliant setups will see slower responses to security vulnerabilities.
- Community <u>was advised</u> to review and align their Domibus deployments with the secure deployment guidelines by 1 May 2024 to ensure they receive timely security updates.


Domibus 5.2 Q4 2024 Domibus 6.0 04 2025

- **Domibus 5.2** release postponed to the end of 2024 (Java 11, WebLogic 14c, Tomcat 9, Oracle 19c, no 12c, possibly HSM support).
- Both the **5.1.x** and **5.0.x** lines will receive support until end Q2 2025 (six months following the final release of Domibus 5.2)
- **Domibus 6.0** release postponed to the end of 2025 (very tentative, support for eDelivery 2.0 profiles, Java 17, Tomcat 10).






What is Two-Factors Authentication and why do we need it? When logging in to EU Login while 2FA is activated, you need to provide a second piece of information beyond your username and passwo rd (e.g., a PIN, a mobile device or smartphone app, or biometric factors such as facial recognition). This second layer of protection will greatly increase the security of data stored on our Confluence spaces and prevent an unauthorized access. Even when a password has been compromised, 2FA can stop unauthorized access since the password alone is not enough to sign in to Confluence. This will greatly increase the security of data stored on our Confluence spaces.
