Digital Verifiable Credential

'Educational ID' is new type of 'Attestation'



To issue the new attestation called 'Educational ID', the student's identity is verified by University at first instance. The 'Educational ID' replaces physical 'Student ID' card with new concept of digital 'Verifiable Credential' issued by University using Europe wide Trusted Framework - EBSI.

Building the foundation of 'Educational ID' (the Attestation)



We work together with EBSI partners <u>University Alliances</u> and <u>GÉANT- eduGAIN</u> to develop a new schema (Verifiable Credential), called <u>Educational ID</u> (the Attestation) for the unique digital identification of the students in Europe.





Educational ID: the Core Building Block of Education Domain

Educational ID VC Schema serves the core component of the building block in Ecosystem that provides University Alliances, Institutions, Organisations, Identity Federations the ability to use the agreed standard verifiable credential schema to exchange, issue and verify Educational ID VC in Europe.





Educational ID Verifiable Credential Schema



EBSI allows to build the next generation of 'Student ID'



We replace student card issued by a specific university with, A UNIVERSAL INTEROPERABLE DIGITAL CREDENTIAL.



Brings a new digital form of Attestation, to shape EDUCATIONAL MOBILITY throughout EUROPE




EBSI registered 'GÉANT' as Root-TAO for the «Educational ID»




