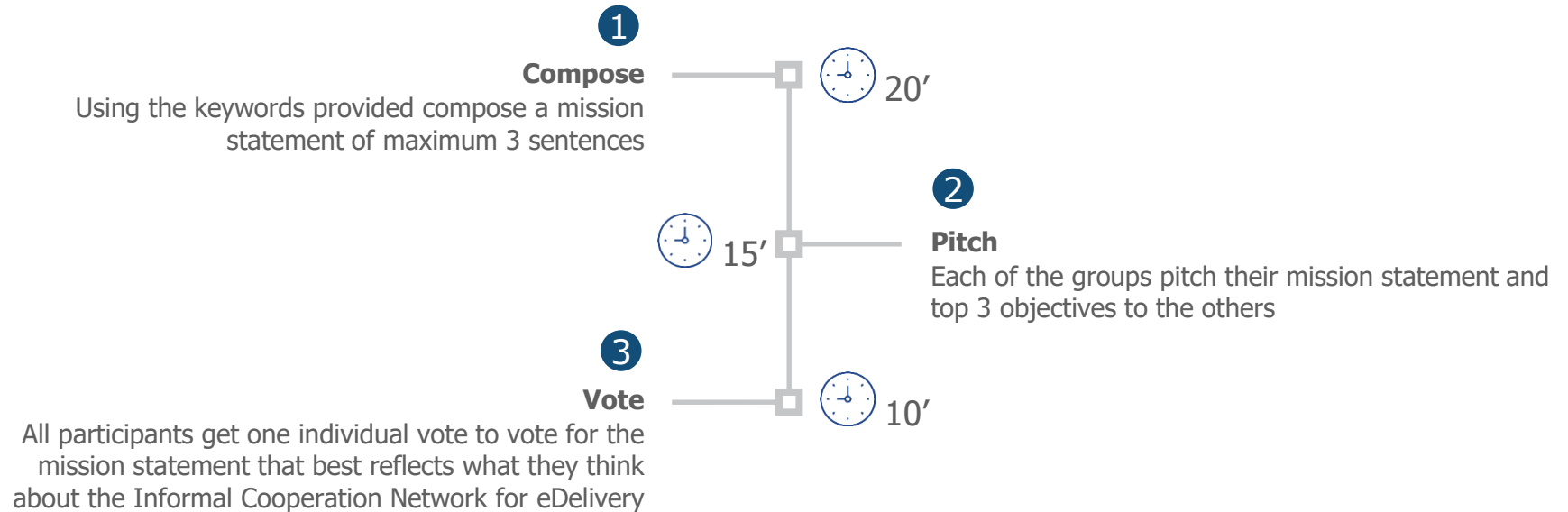

8. **Influence on eDel change management processes**

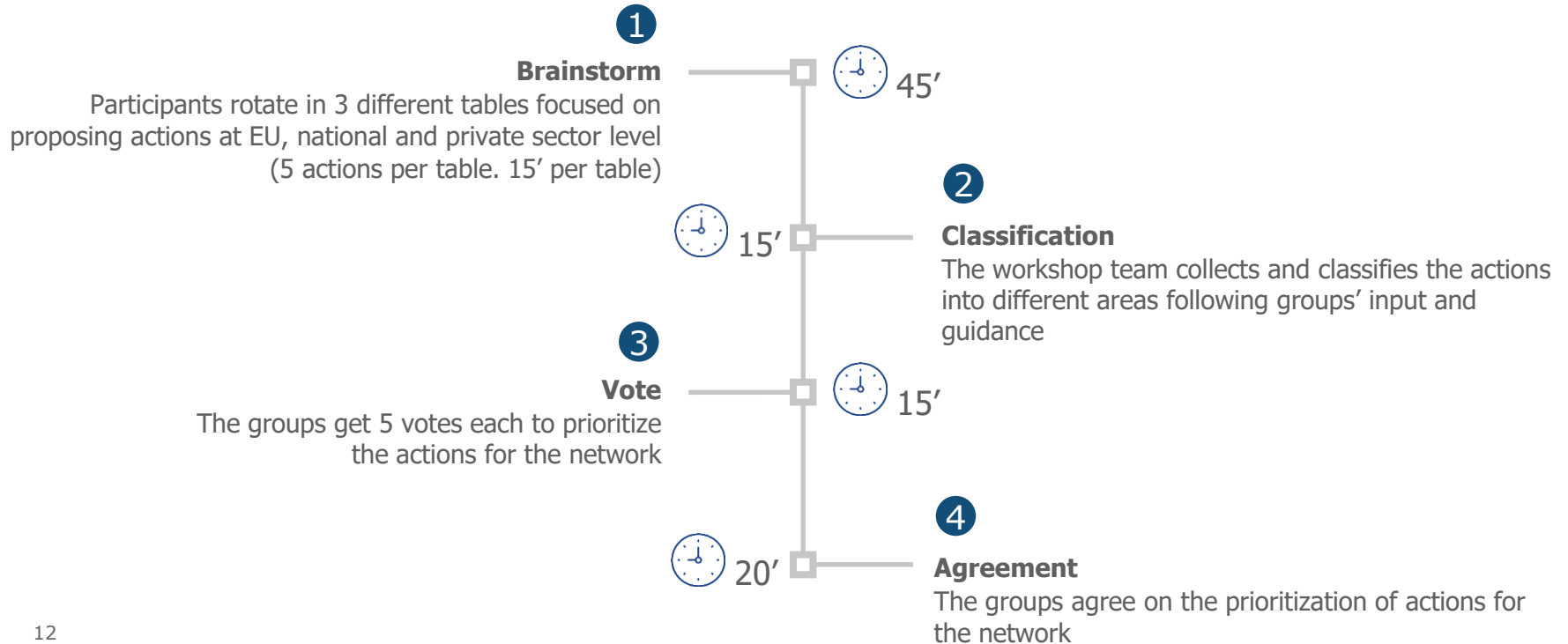

Next steps and actions for the Informal Cooperation Network for eDelivery




Most popular actions

- Create a roadmap for eDelivery to be reused (and adapted as needed) at national levels (4 votes)
- Pushing for national strategies on eDelivery (3 votes)
- Define standards for cross border and cross domain interconnection (3 votes)
- Show positive business case (2 votes)
- Establish eDelivery champions at national level (1 vote)
- See architecture as infrastructure at national level (1 vote)
- Governance interoperability agreements for cross domain (1 vote)
