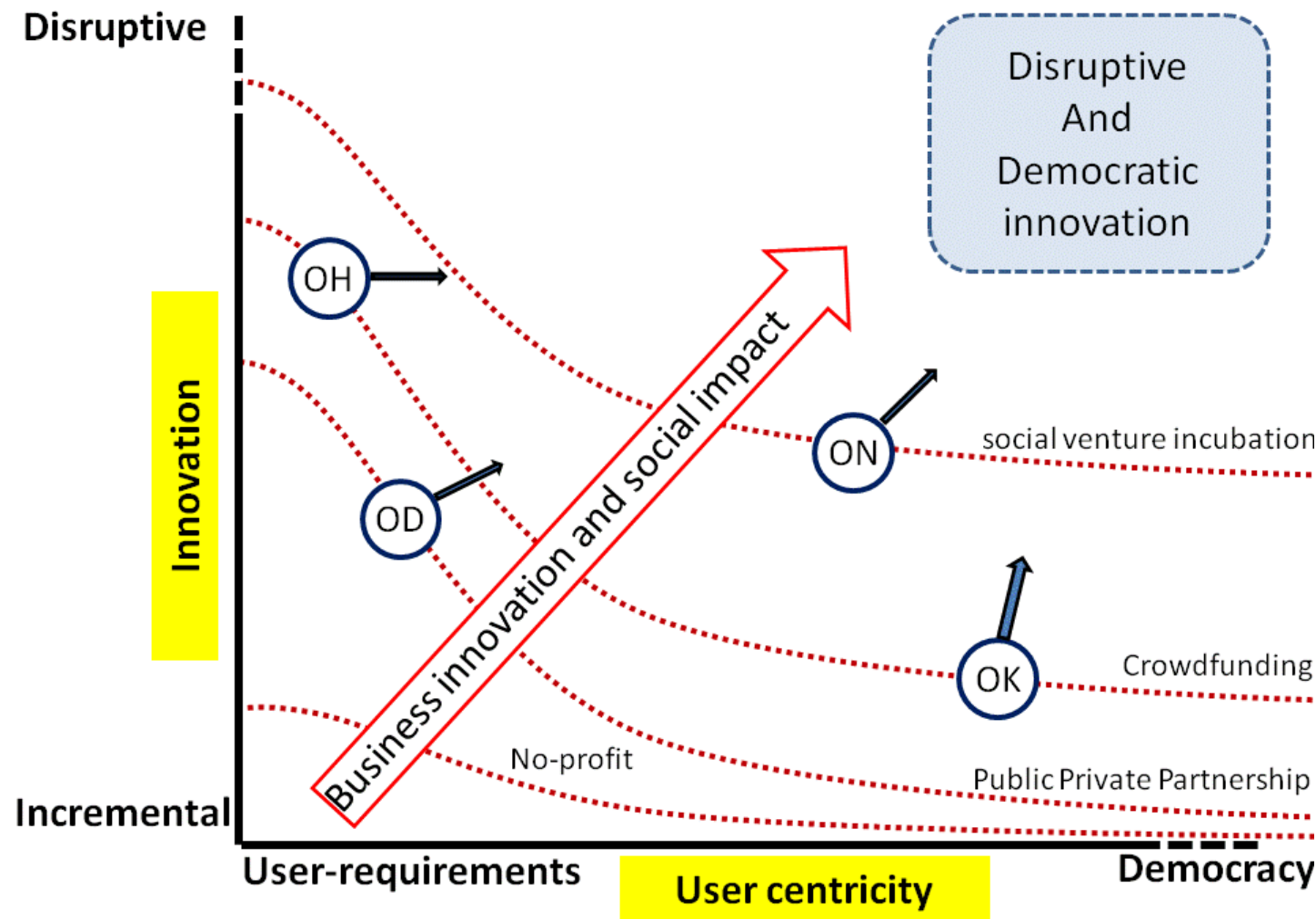

- Innovation Hubs

Technologies / data

- Hardware usage statistics, social sensors
- Voting (whatever)
- Resources cross-database (production, consumption, distribution, etc.)
- Users geographic distribution
- Platforms for distributed content generation

impact

- Check the usage patterns of whatever, interesting both for:
 - **Consumers / people**
 - Awareness, what are other people doing...
 - **Producers**
 - Early detection of 'disruptive' innovation
 - ...there is a business behind...
 - **Cross domain**
 - Distributed production of data, distributed business.
