112 in Estonia

112 is the single emergency number in Estonia.

The European emergency number 112 is the only emergency number in Estonia.

112 calls can be answered in Estonian and also in Russian, English and Finnish (in the north of Estonia). The average time to answer a 112 call is 6 seconds.

Caller location is ensured through Advanced Mobile Location available on Android phones. The accuracy is less than 50 meters in 80% of the cases.

According to the latest E-communications household and telecom single market survey, 65% of Estonians know they can use 112 everywhere in the EU.

Disabled people can access 112 by SMS.
