# 112 in Greece

112 is one of the emergency numbers in Greece

The average time to answer a 112 call is 9 seconds. In addition to Greek, the calls are answered in English and French.

According to the latest E-communications household and telecom single market survey, 13% of Greeks know they can use 112 everywhere in the EU.

The European emergency number 112 is not the only emergency number in Greece:

- 100 - police
- 199 - fire brigade
- 166 - emergency medical service
- 108 - coast guard
- 197 - emergency social assistance

There is no specific help for disabled people.
