112 is the single emergency number in Sweden

The average time to answer a 112 call is 14 seconds. In addition to the national language(s), they are answered in English and in Finnish.

According to the latest E-communications household and telecom single market survey, 57% of Swedes know they can use 112 everywhere in the EU.

The European emergency number 112 is the only emergency number in Sweden.

Disabled end-users can have access to emergency services through SMS as well as Videophone and Total conversation.
