Operational since January 2015, the helpline is operated by [Bílý kruh bezpečí](#) <sup>[4]</sup>.

## 116111 - Child Helplines

The helpline is operated by [Sdružení Linka bezpečí](#) <sup>[5]</sup> - the Safety Line Association
