The Department of Computer Science, [University of Sheffield](#) [1] will establish a Computer Science Ambassador Scheme for secondary school pupils, initially for 45 pupils aged 14-15, involving 60 hours guided experience of digital opportunities. The aims of the scheme are:

- To add value to content available in schools so that young people are equipped to progress to further study in computer science and to digital jobs of the future;
- To demonstrate to future employers that this approach can enhance the secondary school IT curriculum so that it better meets their needs;
- To enhance the professional knowledge of teachers so that they are better prepared to deliver a progressive computer science curriculum;
- For the young people to be ambassadors for digital opportunities in their schools.
