The Antilope project drives eHealth interoperability in Europe and beyond. It unites key national and international organisations to select and define eHealth standards and specifications. The project experts will come together during a first workshop in Copenhagen, Denmark, on 28-29 November 2013. This event is open to everyone who is interested.



This first workshop will serve to validate the Antilope reports, recommendations and education materials with participants drawn primarily from national and international standards organisations, eHealth competence centres, and other stakeholders in the Nordic and Baltic countries.

In the framework of the EU funded Antilope project, key national and international organisations will work together between 2013 and 2015 to select and define eHealth standards and specifications. They will create, validate and disseminate a common approach for testing and certification of eHealth solutions and services in Europe.
