# Work out to catch up

Preterm infants have a higher risk for neurological damage. They are given rehabilitation sessions a few times a week but basic neuroscience indicates that it would be necessary to provide them with an early, intensive and multi-axial intervention. Researchers at the CareToy project want to achieve that in an easy, affordable and efficient way. They have developed a baby gym where preterm babies can be stimulated to rehabilitation techniques at home and with the mere presence of their parents.
