
Business Development

- 70% of the energy production is from hydropower


GDP per capita (adjusted for buying power)




Business structure in Greenland



The labor marked in Greenland




- The labor force is 27.021

Just 0,01% af the unemployed has a short or longer education







Number of licenses granted 2002-2012


